Many call Seattle “The Emerald City.” There is no wizard, but Seattle certainly has an enchantment all of its own. On this tour you will visit the highlights of this magical city, a place that is both dynamic and metropolitan, and replete with natural beauty.

You will see the vibrant tech hub of South Lake Union, and the intriguing Amazon Spheres. You will visit many of the neighborhoods that characterize Seattle’s diverse make-up, including Pioneer Square, the Waterfront, Capitol Hill, the thriving neighborhood around the University of Washington, and beautiful Volunteer Park, designed by John Charles Olmstead, and surrounded by stately homes.

OPTION #1 CITY TOUR including PIKE PLACE MARKET \$95

Your city tour will conclude at the Pike Place Market. Founded in 1907, the Market is one of the oldest and largest continuously operating public markets in the United States. It spans nine historic acres in the center of downtown, where every day, locals and tourists alike shop, visit, eat and discover. Here you will have time to explore on your own. You are sure to find delicious treats to eat, and mementos of your visit. Wear comfortable shoes and walk cautiously as the pavement is old and uneven.

OPTION #2 CITY TOUR including CHIHULY GARDEN AND GLASS \$125

During your city tour you will visit Chihuly Garden and Glass, a showcase and tribute to Dale Chihuly’s magnificent work in glass. The highlight is the Glasshouse, a 40-foot tall, glass and steel structure covering 4,500 square feet of light-filled space. The installation inside is an expansive 100-foot-long sculpture representing one of Chihuly’s largest suspended sculptures. The accompanying galleries and outdoor garden space offer a comprehensive collection of his significant work, demonstrating how he pushed the boundaries of glass as an art medium.

These are not-to-be missed Seattle experiences, and are sure to be highlights of your visit.
